Gulasky Scholarship (York Technical College, Rock Hill, SC)

The Joseph A. & Sue R. Gulasky Scholarship Fund (known as the Gulasky Scholarship) was established in 2024. The Gulasky Scholarship is managed by the Tega Cay Lions Club Foundation which is a charitable non-profit organization. The purpose of the fund is to provide a one-year scholarship of \$500.00 to York Technical College, Rock Hill, SC. To apply for this scholarship, students must meet the eligibility criteria below:

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, the candidate shall be a graduating student in the Fort Mill system or a student of an equivalent educational program, which meets the following requirements.

- Applicants must live in the 29708-zip code area and must provide proof of residency, via the official school transcript or other educational documentation. In lieu of this the applicant must provide a notarized letter from applicant's Guidance Counselor, Principal or other educator stating the applicant is a legal resident in the 29708-zip code and why there is a discrepancy on the transcript regarding his/her address."
- Be a graduating senior who has applied to York Technical College. The scholarship is contingent upon the student's final acceptance.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: A committee composed of two (2) Tega Cay Lions Club & Foundation members and three (3) non-members will review all final applicants and determine the recipient, using a scoring system based on the application and personal interview.

APPLICATION: Complete the application form (which can be obtained from the school counselor or on-line. ALL documents listed on the application checklist must be completed. Application and associated attachments should be sent via United State mail and postmarked no later than the due date to Tega Cay Lions Foundation Scholarship, 2764 Pleasant Road, Box 10425, Fort Mill, SC 29708.

INTERVIEW/AWARDS: After review of applications, selected applicants will be chosen for a personal interview. If selected to receive the scholarship, the recipient, and his/her immediate family, will be invited as guests of honor to the Tega Cay Lions Club & Foundation banquet in May or June of that year.

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable to York Technical College and sent directly to them. The Tega Cay Lions Club & Foundation maintains the exclusive right to determine from year-to-year the amount and eligibility requirements for the scholarship.

FURTHER INFORMATION: The recipient should make every effort to support the Lions Club in the area they reside in, even after graduation.

If the Tega Cay Lions Club Foundation ceases to exist, the scholarship fund will be administered by York Technical College and continue to operate as outlined.
